Motion 1.	To incorporate the following minor changes to the constitution. These changes do not impact the function of the constitution but modernise the wording and aid clarity. Grammatical/Typos - Change group to Group - Change committee to Committee - Change 30st October to 30 th October - Change Common seal to Common Seal Gender neutrality - Change Chairman to Chair - Change his to their - Remove 'Except where inconsistent with the context, all reference to the masculine gender in this constitution shall be deemed to include the feminine' from Section 2 of the Constitution as no longer required with	For	Against	Abstain
	Section 12C Replace: 'At the first meeting of the Committee they shall elect a Chair, Secretary and Treasurer from their number to hold office until the next Annual General Meeting' With: 'At or before the second meeting of the Committee they shall elect a Chair, Secretary and Treasurer from their number to hold office until the next Annual General Meeting. These positions can be shared by committee members.'			



	Section 15 Replace: 'Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained or implied by this Constitution, any Committee of the Group may in addition by Resolution co-opt for the remainder of its term of office any member of the Group who in the opinion of that Committee is able to render special service.' With: 'Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained or implied by this Constitution, any Committee of the Group may by Resolution co-opt for the remainder of its term of office any member of the Group who in the opinion of that Committee is able to render special service, provided that the Committee shall never exceed 13 in number.'		
2.	To amend Section 2 by adding the following 2 points with regards to Southgate: Add:		
	d) Any reference to Island Bay shall include the suburb of Southgate. e) The boundaries of Island Bay and Southgate shall be defined by the Wellington City Council records relating to suburb boundaries. Reason: Amending the constitution to recognise an earlier policy change to include the suburb of Southgate in Island Bay for the purposes of membership of the Island Bay Residents Association Providing a method for determining suburb boundaries		
3.	That the following objects be added to the clause 3 of the Constitution regarding supporting local community groups: i) To raise funds and to accept gifts and donations for the furtherance of the objects of the Society. j) To encourage the formation of community groups and organisations. k) To support community groups and organisations that seek to provide social, recreational, educational and cultural opportunities in the Island Bay Community by advocacy and also through financial grants. Reason: "I have suggested a modification to the objects of IBRA because I believe these provisions were implied in the original rules but their absence could be interpreted as limiting the authority of the Society. The proposed objects make it clear that the Committee is authorised to raise money, hold funds (like it recently did with the South Coast Art Trail) and apply funds on behalf of community groups provided those groups will benefit or create social, recreational, educational and cultural opportunities in the Island Bay Community."		
4.	That Membership criteria be clarified by Replacing: Membership of the Group shall be open to all residents and businesses of Island Bay. All members agree to provide their email and or physical address to the Committee to facilitate communication with them. With: a) Membership of the Group shall be open to all: i. residents aged fifteen years and above; and, ii. businesses of Island Bay. b) All members agree to provide their email and physical address to the Committee to facilitate communication with them. c) A business shall include any business that sells products and / or services and shall include a person or entity which rents residential property in Island Bay Reasons: Providing a lower age limit for membership of the Committee. Providing a definition of an Island Bay business. Requiring members to provide both their physical and email addresses to facilitate communication
