### **PROPOSED ROAD STOPPING – 3 LIFFEY STREET, ISLAND BAY**

Council has received a road stopping application from the owners of 3 Liffey Street.

The road stopping is being carried out under the Local Government Act 1974, legislation that requires consultation with the owners and occupiers of immediately adjoining properties. You have received this letter as the local resident's association. An information sheet on road stopping is attached for your reference.

The area of legal-road land proposed to be stopped is shown in red and green on the attached aerial. Its size has been confirmed by survey as being 23 m<sup>2</sup>.

Legal-road land is not held on a record of title and does not have a legal description. The subject land is situated on Liffey Street, adjoining 3 Liffey Street. If the road stopping proposal is successful, the area outlined in red on the attached aerial would be sold to the owners of this property and amalgamated with their existing title. The areas shown in green would remain in Council ownership.
